The martini is a twist on a classic Dirty Martini—shaken, not stirred of course—and is priced at £18. That's a whopping \$36! Luckily, you can make your own. Here's how.

The Belvedere Spectre 007 Martini

- 2 oz of vodka
- ¼ oz dry vermouth
- 2 Sicilian green olives
- A dash of Sicilian green olive brine

Gently muddle an olive in the base of the mixing glass. Add the remaining ingredients and shake hard with ice. Double strain into a chilled martini glass and garnish with one olive.
