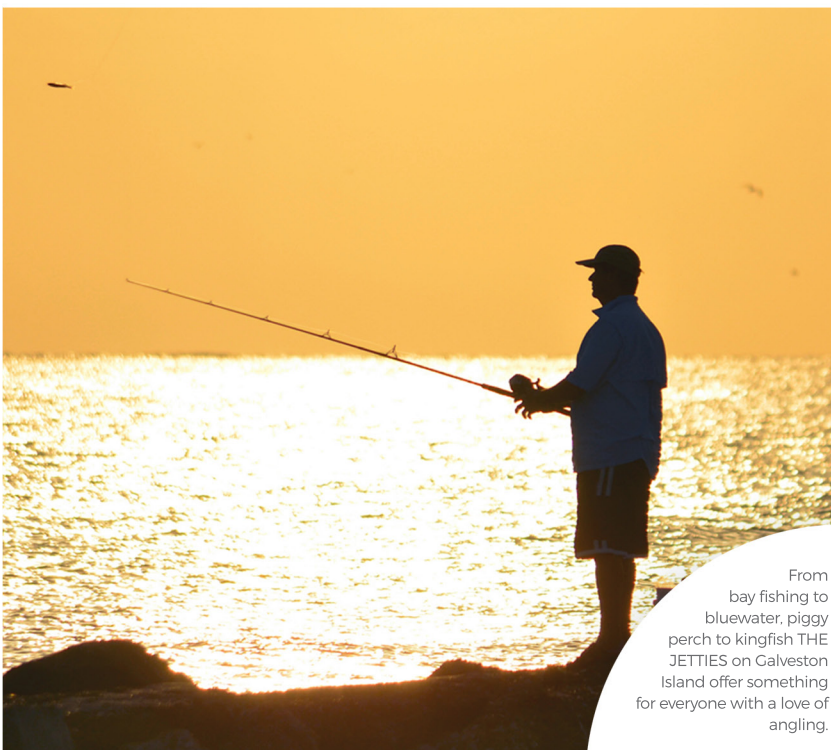


# COASTAL DESTINATION SPOTLIGHT
